Online applications are invited from eligible residents of Union Territory of Ladakh for the post of constable **Executive**, **Armed/IRP**, **HG/CD/SDRF** cadre in Ladakh Police against (264) vacancies in the pay Level-2 (19900-63200).

The detailed terms and conditions with regards to eligibility, educational qualification, age, physical standard, desired qualifications, mode of recruitment, reservation quota in recruitment etc. are as follows. -
