3. Educational Qualification:

Candidate should possess the following requisite Educational Qualification:

Note : (i) Educational qualification must be from a Govt. Recognized Board/ Council/Institutions etc. (Minimum educational qualification should be as applicable to the post offered for NTPC posts).

(ii) For appointment against Sports quota in **Technician-III**, the minimum educational qualification is 10th pass. However, the training period for such Sports Quota appointees will be 03 (Three) years, unless they pass/ Possess ITI qualification in the relevant Trade, in which case it will be 6 months.

4. Age: (a) Minimum age 18 years and maximum age 25 years **as on 01-January-2024**. No relaxation in upper or lower age limit will be permissible in this recruitment. (b) Proof of Age viz., Matriculation certificate issued by a recognised board or equivalent must be produced / attached.

5. Period for Reckoning Sports Achievement: For recruitment against Sports Quota through Open Advertisement, the recognized sports achievement should be in the current and or immediate previous two-financial year and the sports person shall be an active player. The sports achievement in recognized championships / events on or after 01.04.2021 shall only be considered for appointment. For validity of sports achievement, concluding day of the championships events shall be taken into account.

6. Sports Norms: The minimum sports norms for recruitment of sportspersons against sports quota in different Grade Pay and Pay Bands for both team and individual events shall be as per the table shown below:

Note: In boxing discipline, the achievements of players in "Youth" category on or after 25.09.2016 in International Championships will be considered in place of "Junior" category.

(a) In Athletics, medal winning performance in National Inter State Senior Athletics Championships, may also be considered for recruitment against the posts having Grade pay Rs 1900 in pay Band Rs 5200-20,200.

(b) In Archery, Participation and medal winning performance after 25.11.2020 in the events organized by Archery Association of India led by Shri Arjun Munda as president, as National Sports Federation for the sport of archery in India will be considered for recruitment.

(c) In Badminton & Table Tennis; sportspersons may also be considered for recruitment on the basis of their current Annual All India Rankings; in different Grade Pay and Pay Bands, as per following criteria:

(d) In Cricket (Women) at international level, representation of Main Indian Seniors Team in a Test Match or in a Limited Overs One Day International Match or in a Twenty-20 Overs Match; shall also be considered for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay Rs. 1900 or Rs. 2000 in Pay Band Rs. 5,200 - 20,200/- (Level- 2 & Level- 3).

In **Cricket (Women)** at National level, following sports achievements in 4 Days/One Day Limited Overs/Twenty-20 Overs Women Cricket Championships; organized under the aegis of BCCI; may also be considered for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay Rs. 1800 or Rs. 1900 in Pay Band Rs. 5,200 – 20,200 :-

In Cricket Men Section, following achievements may also be considered for recruitment in GP- 2000/1900:

(i) Quarter finalist in Senior/ U-25/ U-19 All India Inter State Elite Group Championship and All India Inter State Championships may be considered for GP 2000/1900 or

(ii) Participation in Senior/ U-25/ U-19 All India Senior Inter- zonal Championship.

(e) Basketball: The sports achievements in the events conducted by Basketball Federation of India after 26.07.2017 shall be considered for recruitment.

(f) Volleyball: The sports achievements in the events conducted by Volleyball Federation of India after 20.07.2017 shall be considered for recruitment. Participation and medal winning performance upto 25.06.2020 in the events organized by Volleyball Federation of India lead by Shri Ramavatar Singh Jhakar as Secretary General will be considered for recruitment. But event conducted by Volleyball Federation of India or its affiliated units after 25.06.2020 shall not be considered for recruitment. However, the certificates issued by the Association of Indian Universities and the International Federations for recognized Sports Achievements in the Game of Volleyball, will be valid for recruitment.

(g) Boxing: The sports achievements in the events conducted by Boxing Federation of India after 28.10.2016 shall be considered for recruitment. **Note:-** In Boxing discipline the achievement in “Youth Category” in International Championship will be considered in place of “Junior Category” as per RBE-20/2018.

(h) Power lifting: The sports achievements in the event conducted by Indian Power lifting Federation (IPF) or its affiliated units after 03.10.2017 shall not be considered for recruitment. However, the certificates issued by the Association of Indian Universities and the International Federations for recognized sports achievement in the game of Power lifting will be permissible for said purpose as per RBE No. 76/2018.

(i) Football : The mandatory condition for recruitment Under-21 players in the Santosh trophy has been excluded. Junior National Football Championship for B.C. Roy Trophy is to be considered for recruitment Under-19. Age condition is to be remained as applicable for other games.

(j) Weightlifting :- The eligibility for recruitment & trials for considering the cases of Weightlifters having recognized sports achievements as per old and new weight categories, shall be as under:-

* All the championships should be conducted under the aegis of recognized International/National/State sports and Federations and also recognized by the Railway Sports Promotion Board.

* A sportsperson will be considered for recruitment only for event/position/game advertised in which he/she has recognized sports norms. Sportsperson having sports achievement/eligibility norms for post carrying higher Grade Pay will also be eligible for post carrying lower Grade Pay. **Separate applications for each category (Grade Pay) should be made along with requisite examination fees.**

7. Selection Procedure: Short-listed eligible candidates will be called for -

(i) Trial of sports performance.

(ii) Interview and assessment of sports achievement, educational qualification etc.

NOTE: Only those candidates who perform better than the existing railway sportspersons in their respective events, and if they fit into the NFRSA team, will be considered for appointment.

8. Procedure for Recruitment:

(a) Trials of the candidates shall be conducted to assess their sports performance and suitability for Railway/Unit team as well as Indian Railways team. Trial Committee shall give its recommendation in terms of either FIT or NOT FIT, for consideration for next stage, by giving marks (maximum 40 marks), as per the criteria given below:

(i) For game skill, physical fitness & coach's observations during trials : 40 Marks

(ii) FIT Candidate : Candidate securing 25 marks or more

(iii) NOT FIT Candidate : Candidate securing marks below 25

(b) After Trial only the FIT candidates shall be considered for the next stage i.e., interview stage by the Recruitment Committee. Recruitment Committee shall award 60 marks for sports achievement and educational qualification as per following marks distribution indicated at (f) below.

(c) Recruitment Committee shall take interviews and award the marks (out of 60 marks) only to the FIT candidates for their sports achievements, educational qualifications etc. Candidates declared 'NOT FIT' will not be assessed further by the Recruitment Committee.

(d) Interviews of the candidates shall invariably be held on the same day, just after trials or at the most, next day of the trials.

(e) Recruitment Committee is to add the marks given by the Trial Committee to the FIT candidates (i.e., out of 40 Marks), in order to make the final merit list (out of 100 Marks).

(f) **Distribution of Marks:** Maximum marks which can be awarded by the Trial Committee for performance during Trial and Recruitment Committee during Interview stage, shall be as follows:-

(i) For game skill, physical fitness & Coach's observations during Trials : 40 Marks

(ii) For assessment of recognized Sports Achievements as per norms : 50 Marks

(iii) Educational Qualification : 10 Marks

Total : 100 Marks

Note: For educational qualification, 6 (six) marks shall be given to the candidate fulfilling only the minimum educational qualification, to the post against which he/she is being considered for appointment. Candidate having higher educational qualification shall be given higher marks.

(g) Minimum qualifying marks for recruitment through Open Advertisement in different Grade Pay and Pay Bands, shall be as follows:-

NOTE: The offer of appointment shall be given purely on the basis of merit. In case more than one sportsperson score the same marks, preference should be given to younger candidate to decide the merit.

09. All the candidates getting appointment through Sports Quota will undergo probation period of two years.

10. Essential Certificates/Documents Required: Photocopy of certificates of sports performance, educational qualification, date of birth, caste, etc. should be sent duly self-attested along with the application. There is no reservation for SC/ST/OBC/ EWS being a sub-quota. However, the candidates claiming to belong to SC/ST/OBC/EWS communities are required to submit self-attested photocopy of Caste Certificate issued by the Competent Authority. In case of OBC-NCL Certificate, it should not be older than one year at the time of trial / interview.

11. HOW TO APPLY: Candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria should apply as per application format given at **Annexure-A** by the candidate in his/her own handwriting on a good quality A-4 size plain paper along with two recent (taken within last two months) passport size photographs duly self-attested without wearing any wig, cap or coloured glasses. The application should be duly filled and signed by the candidate in his/her own handwriting.

Recruitment against GP Rs.1800 (Pay Band-1/ Level - 1) : Candidates are instructed to submit single application for a single event in GP Rs. 1800, Level-1 only, otherwise his/her candidature is liable to be rejected.

Recruitment against GP Rs.1900 / Rs. 2000 (Pay Band-1, Level - 2 & 3): Candidates who apply for the event in GP Rs. 1900/- , he / she is also eligible to apply for the event in GP Rs. 1800/- **if desired.**

Note : Allotment of post / Division shall be decided by the Railway Administration as per administrative requirement.

Applications must be sent through ordinary post addressed to **Senior Personnel Officer (Recruitment), Northeast Frontier Railway HQ, Maligaon, Guwahati - 781 011 (Assam)** OR dropped physically in the APPLICATION DROP BOX in the Recruitment Section in the Office of Pr. Chief Personnel Officer, NF Railway HQ,

Maligaon, Guwahati (Assam)-781011 **on or before 23.10.2023**. (For candidates residing in Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Jammu & Kashmir, Lahaul & Spiti Districts, Pangi Sub-Division in Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, and Lakshadweep the last date is **03.11.2023** by post only).

The envelope should be superscribed "**RECRUITMENT AGAINST SPORTS QUOTA:: EVENT NAME -, POSITION.....GP Rs.....**".

12. FEES: (i) *For all candidates except those mentioned in sub-para (ii) below: Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred) only with a provision for refunding Rs. 400/- to candidates actually appearing in the trial*. The IPO should be drawn in favour of PFA /NF Railway, and payable at **Maligaon Post Office, Guwahati - 781011 only**. Candidates must write their names & full address in the IPO.

(ii) *For candidates belonging to SC/ST/Ex. Servicemen, Women, Minorities and Economically Backward Classes: Rs. 250/- (Rupees Two Hundred Fifty) only with a provision for refunding the same to those who actually appear in the trial.*

(iii) '**Minority**' means Muslims, Christians, Buddhists, Zoroastrians (Parsis) & Sikhs. **Economically backward classes** will mean those candidates whose family income is less than Rs. 50,000/- per annum. The following officials are authorized to issue income certificate for the purpose of identifying economically backward classes:

- (a) District Magistrate or any other Revenue Officer up to the level of Tehsildar.
- (b) Sitting MP of Lok Sabha for persons of their own constituency.
- (c) BPL Card or any other certificate issued by Central Government under a recognized poverty alleviation programme or Izzat MST issued by Railways.
- (d) Union Minister may also recommend for any persons from anywhere in the country.
- (e) Sitting MP of Rajya Sabha for persons of the District in which the MP normally resides.

The income certificate issued by the authorities mentioned in Para - 12 (iii) above must be as per format given at **Annexure-B** enclosed herewith. This will have to be issued on the letterhead of the issuing authority.

(iv) A candidate applying for more than one GP/ event must submit **separate applications with separate IPOs** and complete documents for each event.

13. Medical Examination: The sportsperson (male/female) appointed, must fulfil the minimum medical norms for the post, for which he/she is being appointed.

14. Important Instructions:

- i. Eligibility will be considered only on the strength of information provided in the application.
- ii. Candidate who does not possess minimum educational qualification, achievements, sports norms etc. as on date of notification need not apply.
- iii. Candidates should carefully read the instructions mentioned hereunder before filling up the application form. The form can be downloaded from **www.nfr.indianrailways.gov.in**.
- iv. The candidate has to fill up required information in his/her own handwriting using blue / black ball point pen. Application filled in any language other than Hindi / English and having any change in the format of application will lead to rejection of application summarily.
- v. Spellings of name, father's name and other details in the application form must be as per the original certificates. If any discrepancy is found, the application can be rejected at any stage of the selection.
- vi. Application which is not as per format (**Annexure-A**) will be rejected.
- vii. The candidature of candidate may also be rejected if (a) the candidate submits multiple applications for the same post and category (b) the candidate submits multiple applications with different community for the same post & category; (c) the candidate submits multiple applications with different photo (face) for same post & category.
- viii. Unsigned applications OR signature in block letters OR incomplete applications will be rejected.
- ix. If left thumb impression not affixed/blurred/smudged on the application form, the application will be rejected.
- x. The application will be rejected if the applicants are found over aged, under aged, date of birth unfilled or wrongly filled.
- xi. IPO issued before the date of issue of Employment Notice will not be accepted and the application will be rejected.
- xii. Candidates must write their name and address on the IPO and enclose it with the application form with one self-addressed stamped (worth Rs. 6/-) envelope (size 24x10 cm).
- xiii. IPO should be drawn in favour of PFA/N.F.Railway and payable at Maligaon Post Office only, otherwise application will be rejected.
- xiv. Applications received with cash/cheque/Central Recruitment Stamp OR money order will not be accepted and application will be rejected.
- xv. Candidature of those candidates who fail to appear for trials, interview and other selection procedures on the date and venue fixed for the purpose, will be cancelled without further notice.
- xvi. Railway Administration reserves all rights for recruitment of sports persons at any time/position for which suitable outstanding sports persons are available.

- xvii. The application can be filled in either English or Hindi but item nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11 & 18 should be filled up in English only.
